		<b>SAFETY</b> - Refer to SWS Storage for MAXIMUM Safe Working Loads (SWSL) apply to the structure.	
UNEVEN POINT LOAD REFER TO SUPPLIER		<b>INSPECTION PROCEDURES</b> - Conduct regular INSPECTIONS to check for: - Structural damage (e.g. Overload or movement of structure components) - Corrosion, degradation and wear - Loads are within allowable safety limits - Ensure all components are correctly fitted	
MAX BEAM LEVEL UDL (KG)		<b>STRUCTURAL DAMAGE &amp; TRAINING</b> - Inspect operators on construction of pallet handling equipment - Ensure correct clearance are maintained between racking and stored unit loads - Ensure products are secured to the pallet - Report all damage to Forklifts Service	
MAX BAY LOAD (KG)		<b>ALTERATIONS TO STRUCTURES</b> - DO NOT alter the structure without: - Checking against manufacturer's technical data - Obtain approval from supplier - Refer to supplier load sign for safe working loads - If in doubt ALWAYS contact your equipment supplier

# SHELVING INSPECTIONS

Mildura Forklifts have a racking inspection program that complies with WorkSafe and the AS4084:2023. It identifies any safety related problems before the hazard causes any harm, damage to property, or impacts the environment. By having your racking inspected annually, you are not only following the AS4084:2023 standard but you are also creating a safe work environment for yourself and those around you by ensuring:

- The racking is being handled in the correct manner,
- The Safe Working Load signs are being adhered to,
- That all racking is in its original state and has not been adjusted in any way, shape or form.
- The extent of any damage resulting from impacting the racking,
- There are no signs of any dislocation or deformation of sections or connections for uprights and beams and there are no signs of cracking at the welds of the connectors.

As part of your annual racking audit with Mildura Forklifts, you will receive a report which will outline any issues, notify you of any damage or defects and deliver detailed compliance requirements to assure the standard is being followed.

Annual racking audits help identify existing rack damage that could potentially compromise your racking performance. Failure to have your racking system annually audited could result in litigation and could carry potential penalties in the case of an incident or accident.
